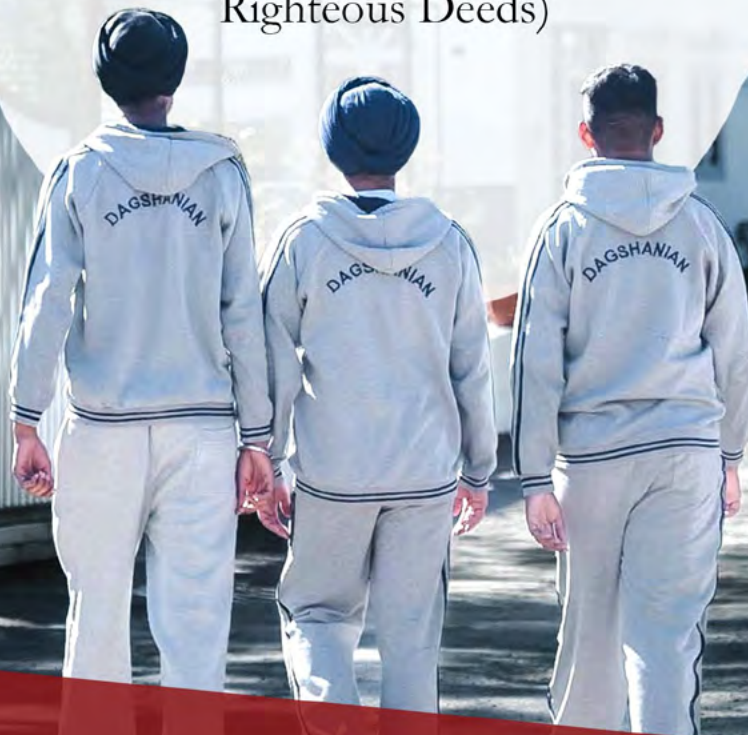

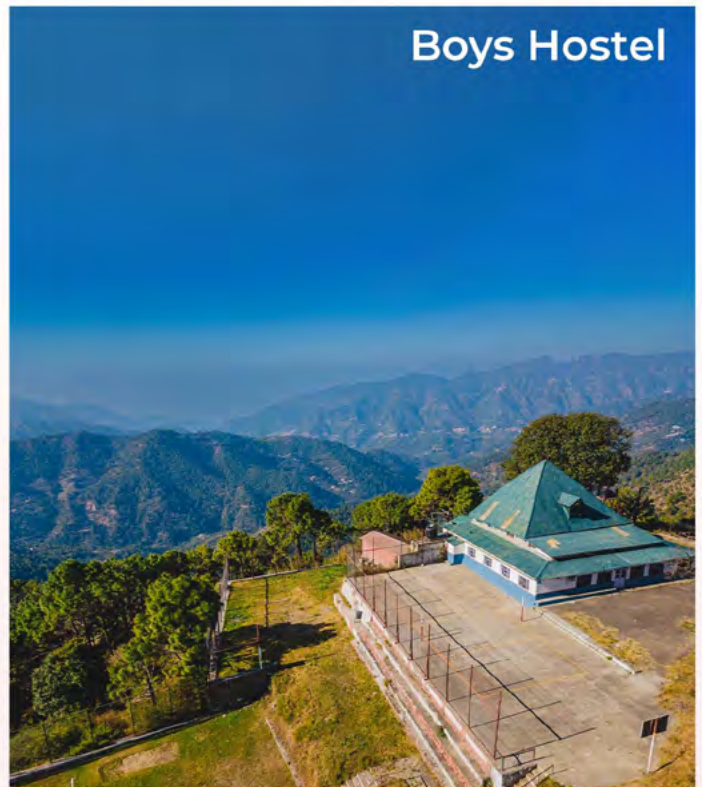
The school has rendered seven decades of dedicated service to the nation.

It's a heritage school with a difference, committed to excellence, enhancing holistic growth of the students.



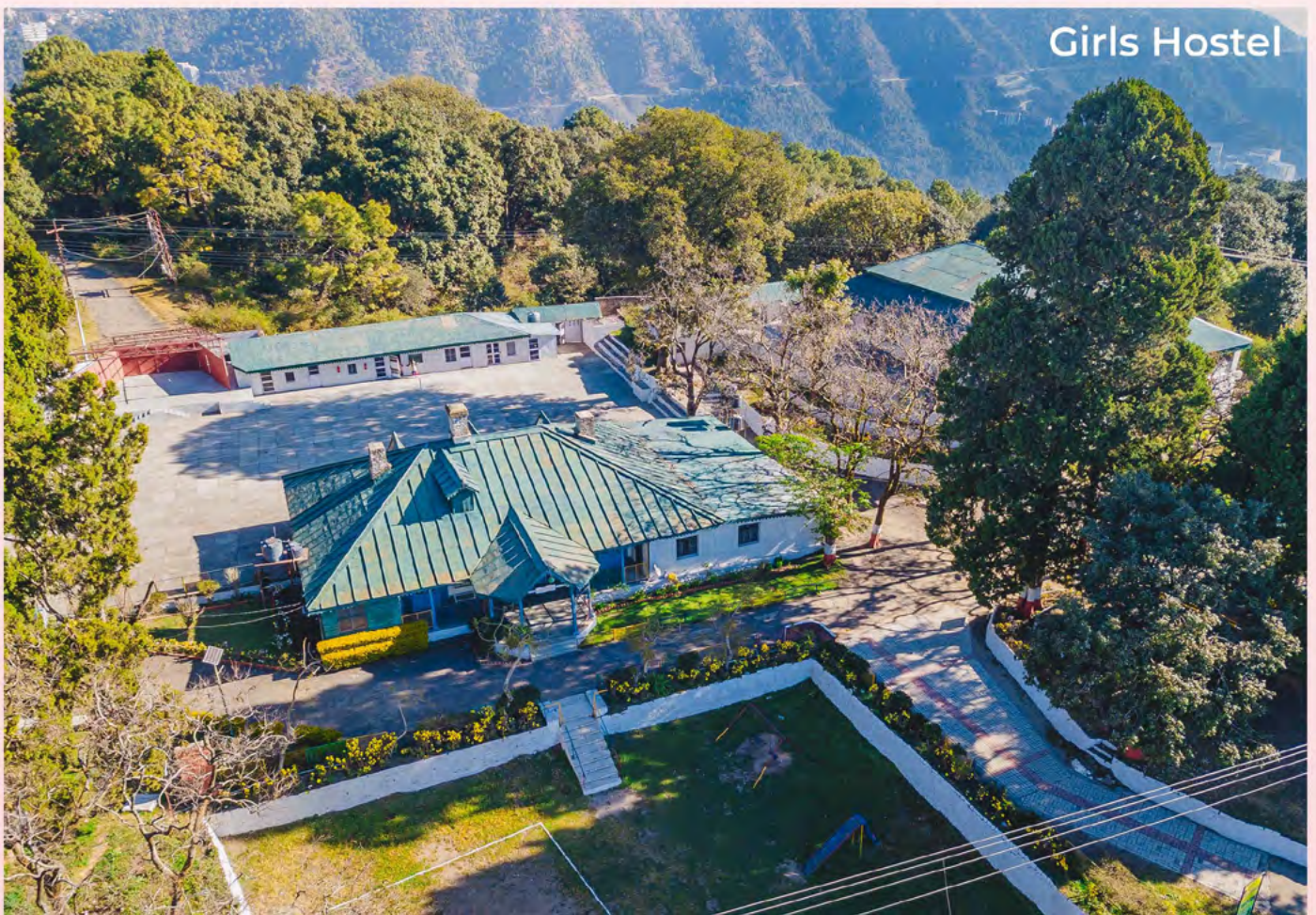
About Dagshai Public School

There are separate hostels for girls and boys. Basic amenities, congenial and hygienic living conditions are provided. Clean drinking water through RO machines is facilitated in each hostel. Pest control at regular intervals, keeps the precincts clean and healthy. A close-knit student-teacher community helps the children to adjust to hostel life. NRI students are part of our school strength.

Our Ambience

Amidst a grove of deciduous trees, twelve well maintained school buildings are aesthetically interspersed on an undulating and pristine landscape. The built-in area is a vestige of the Colonial Era, with all the modern amenities in place.

Our sprawling 30 acres campus has a network of well laid out roads to enable easy accessibility to all areas.

Established in the military cantonment of Dagshai, the school estate exudes an unmistakable old-world charm. The entire campus is very secure, being in the middle of a well-protected, large army station.



The criteria of a good residential school lies in the effective support system it offers growing children, to enable them to overcome their anxieties and complexes while relieving them of modern day pressures. The counselling support offered in our school for any maladjustment or behavioural issue is a sincere initiative to help youngsters adapt to changing times. Under a strict vigilance, the students remain safe and secure, far away from the social nuisances of urban life which tend to lead them astray.

A Healthy Lifestyle

The dwellers breathe oxygen in uncontaminated freshness and soak in the peaceful yet so ostensibly resplendent an environment.

Its cool and salubrious climate is ideal for those seeking a refreshing atmosphere for their wards to thrive in. The school's expansive campus affords great opportunities for the physical growth of children through pathways meant for walking and jogging.

A resident nurse takes care of the health issues of the staff and students. Medical camps / workshops are periodically held. There are regular medical check-ups and timely inoculations to keep the children healthy and robust. Individual Medical Cards of the students record their physical status.

Academic Focus

Academic excellence is our top priority. Our experienced and well qualified staff give personalised attention to students through modern teaching aids and techniques to foster innovative learning.

Our exceptional and unmatched teacher-student ratio is 1:9.

Professional development programmes through workshops are conducted regularly for our teaching faculty so as to refresh, enrich and broaden their vocational knowledge and skills.

Dagshai Public School was the first school in Himachal Pradesh to be affiliated to CISCE (Council For The Indian School Certificate Examinations), which conducts the ICSE (Class X) and ISC (Class XII) Board Exams. Our Council Code/ Registration Number is HP001.



Our school is an active member of the ASISC (Association of Schools for Indian School Certificate).



Cent percent First Divisions with high subject scores of our Board Classes is a matter of great pride for us.

Special academic arrangements are made for the under achievers through individual / group coaching.

Emphasis is laid on Spoken English, Calligraphy, Creative Writing, Public Speaking, General Knowledge and Current Affairs.

Hobby Clubs

In order to gratify avocational interests, students are free to pursue a hobby or two. A variety of Clubs – Scientific Modelling, Dramatics, Histrionics, Speech Eloquence, Graphic Designing, Photography, Philately, Culinary Art, Book Browsing, Horticulture, Pen Craft, Fine Arts and Performing Arts are popular among students.

Classroom teaching is augmented through smart classes, experimentation, excursions and project work.



Environmental issues and community service are an integral part of school education, helping our students to cultivate wholesome and responsible attitudes as future adult members for our society.

Computer education is compulsory from class I. Children are well-versed in the intricacies of computer jargon.

An adequately stocked school library and mini libraries in the hostel enhance the reading inclinations of our students.

Creativity and aesthetics are simultaneously encouraged with scientific and digital technology. Art and Craft, Painting, Music, Choreography, Elocution, Dramatics, Oratory receive as much attention as Athletics, Yoga, Games and Sports. Children are prepared to participate and bag positions at the Zonal, State, National and International competitions.



Sports / Outdoor Activities

The school offers excellent sports facilities. It has a well-maintained Stadium, Tennis, Basket Ball and Volley Ball Courts, Cricket and Skating Grounds. Yoga, Karate and Gymnastics are practised and the abilities of the players are honed through seasoned coaches. Exposure to different games at the Junior, Middle and Senior School level is given initially. Each child is free to select his own games to be properly coached in.







The School organises annual outstation trips for students, educational and entertaining.

NCC is widely opted by our students. Mountaineering, trekking, camping, rifle shooting and adventure sports are an annual feature.

There is an active Student Council where leadership qualities through the prefectorial system is intensified.

Career counselling for Senior School is conducted by professionals.

Three subject streams are available for the Board Classes – Science, Humanities and Commerce. The council offers a flexible curriculum selection as per the New Education Policy, 2020.

PTMs (Parent Teacher Meets) and orientation programmes / workshops are held at regular intervals.
